A Word about the Lord's Supper

During the last evening that He spent with His disciples, the Lord Jesus instituted the Lord's Supper and requested that His followers partake of the emblems (bread and wine) in remembrance of Him (Luke 22:19-20; 1 Corinthians 11:20-34).

We meet weekly on Sunday mornings in obedience to this request. If you are a believer in the Lord Jesus who participates in such an act of remembrance in your home church, we welcome you to share with us in taking the emblems. Otherwise, you are welcome to attend the meeting as an observer but we request that you refrain from taking the bread and wine.

The format may be a little different from what you are used to in that no one is appointed to preside. The meeting takes the form of spontaneous expressions of worship by the men in prayers, hymns, reading and expounding of the Scriptures (1 Corinthians 14:26), and partaking of the emblems.
